Some of the video shots we will take are listed below. We can talk about any additional specialty shots with you when we discuss your wedding with you.

Wedding

- Exterior of the church.
- Bride and bridesmaids getting ready for the service.
- Wedding party arriving at church.
- (Two or three camera) Continuous roll of ceremony, from prior to bride's entrance to the couple's walk down the aisle at the end.
- (Two or three camera) Specialty shots: soloist, choir, unity candle lighting, etc.
- (Two-camera minimum) Reaction shots of bride and groom's families.
- Video will be taken during the photographer's formal posed shots.
- Wedding party leaving the church.

Reception Section

- Wedding party arriving at the reception.
- Bride and groom entering the reception.
- First dance.
- Mom's dance with the groom.
- Dad's dance with the bride.
- Best man's toast
- Cake cutting.
- Garter toss.
- Bouquet toss.
- Guest book signings.
- Special dances and ceremonies at the reception.
- Interviews with guests, if requested.
- Interview with the bride and groom if requested.
- Cutaways – Cake, presents, decorations, flower arrangements, the DJ.
- Copy of the wedding announcement, souvenir napkins, etc.
- Guests saying goodbye and bride and groom leaving from reception.

Interview questions for guest

- What can you tell me about how the bride and groom met?
- What did you feel when you learned they were engaged?
- What do you think the groom should do to keep the bride happy?
- Where do you think they will be ten years from now?
- What do you think the bride loves most about the groom?

Interview questions for the bride and groom individually

- How did you meet?
- Tell me how the relationship deepened and grew.
- When did you first know he/she was the 'one'?
- Tell me about how you (he) proposed.
- What are your plans for the future?
